Answer all the questions below by visiting different points of interest on the UBC Vancouver campus. Show your answers to the front desk staff at the UBC Welcome Centre in the Robert H. Lee Alumni Centre to collect your stamps

1. **The UBC Bookstore** first opened in 1917 and is still a busy place on campus. What are the hours of operation on Saturdays? Bonus: show your challenge passport and get a 12% discount!

2. Outside the **Pacific Museum of Earth** is the Wheaton Walk Through Time – a geological and biological history of earth. How many years in the past does the timeline start?

3. **The Rose Garden lookout**, just north of Flag Pole Plaza, reveals iconic ocean and mountain views. Find the plaque and name two of the visible mountain peaks.

4. Did you know visitors can stay overnight at UBC? **Orca House** is a hotel that is part of the Gage Suites & Signature Studios at UBC. What is the Indigenous name of Orca House?

In 1948 UBC was granted permission by the Kwakwaka' wakw people
of BC to use the Thunderbird for varsity sports teams. What is the name
of the totem pole that was gifted? It's replica still stands outside of
Brock Hall today.

6. In the UBC **Welcome Centre** at the Robert H. Lee Alumni Centre look at the dark wall across from the front desk – what is the graduation date of the building's namesake?
